iPad

Overview

- iPad tablets are intuitive by design with touchscreens and visual interfaces.
- They also have a whole range of built in accessibility features such as VoiceOver (a screen reader), Siri (voice command option) and dictation features, guided screen options and assistive touch and switch control features.



Step by Step

 The iPad has a sleep/wake button on the top write hand corner of the device. Click this once to snooze or wake the iPad. To turn the device off completely hold this button down and then swipe the screen as directed. To restart the device hold the button down until the apple symbol appears on the screen.





2. To return to the home screen from any application click on the home button on the front of the device below the screen.
