Course Title:	Eyegaze Training
Duration:	1 day
Purpose:	 <p>Eyegaze is a pioneering eye-operated computer input system that empowers people with disabilities to communicate and interact with computers. It's a great way of empowering life-limited children to play and learn, to be creative, to communicate and to control something for themselves. In the course we will look at how to set up the Eyegaze, how to position and calibrate it for individual users, how to use it with a variety of different software packages.</p>
