Self-guided activities for Mobile Magic Carpet

ACTIVITY 1 - Familiarisation

1. Familiarise yourself with the magic carpet controls.

Can you locate the following on the Mobile Magic Carpet itself? Try labelling the pictures below.

- Power button
- Projector power button
- USB port
- Volume controls (depending on your version of the magic carpet they may only be accessible from the keyboard)
- Height controls



What is the procedure you should follow when shutting down the Mobile Magic Carpet?





2. Familiarise yourself with the keyboard.

Can you locate the following:

- On/off button
- Volume controls
- Mousepad
- Left click and right click mouse functions
- Esc button



These are the main parts of the keyboard you will need to perform the majority of actions within the Mobile Magic Carpet.

What should you do if you find the keyboard is not working?

3. Familiarise yourself with the main screen.

Can you locate the following?

- Power icon Categories icon
- Builder icon Favourites icon

ACTIVITY 2 – iPad control

1. List the steps to connect to the Magic Carpets WiFi

2. Open the Mobile Magic Carpet icon. Familiarise yourself with the main screen. Can you locate the following

Power icon

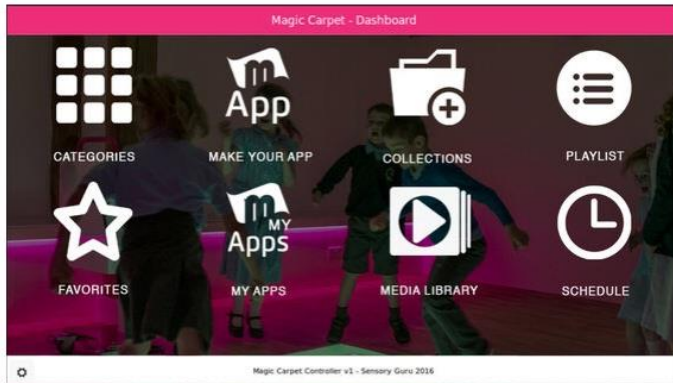
Categories icon

ACTIVITY 3 – Creating customised apps

1. Using the iPad

- Take images using the iPad camera.
- Use the Beamz application or Garage Band to record some music you have created.

You now have images and audio to create your applications.

- Create a scatter application on the Mobile Magic Carpet using the iPad using the images and audio clips you have just taken. Don't forget to save and name your application.

2. Using the keyboard

- Take images either from the media library or upload via the USB port. Do the same with audio clips.
- Create an application on the Mobile Magic Carpet using the keyboard. Use the images and audio clips you have just uploaded. Don't forget to save and name your application.

3. What issues did you come across using the iPad vs the keyboard?

4. What are the benefits for the children you have for creating personalised applications?

5. Try creating a different template.

- What is the difference between 'save and test' and publishing to server?
