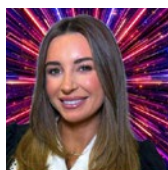
1. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: LACEY TURNER

Dani Dyer is a TV personality, broadcaster and author.



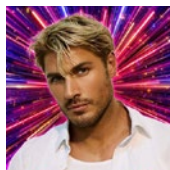
3. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: DELTA GOODREM

Delta Goodrem is a singer-songwriter, actress, philanthropist, and entrepreneur.



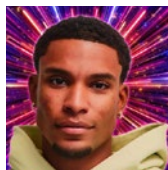
4. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: CHRIS APPLETON

Will Best is a TV and radio host with over 15 years of broadcasting experience



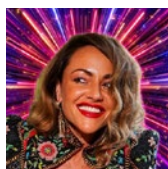
7. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: DAME SARAH STOREY

Dame Sarah's 19 Paralympic gold medals make her the most successful British Paralympian of all time.



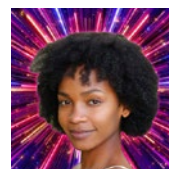
8. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: JAIME WINSTONE

Jaime is one of Britain's most recognisable screen talents, starring in a string of acclaimed and iconic films.



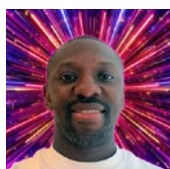
9. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: BETHANY ANTONIA

Lawrence is best known for his role in ITV's Emmerdale as Mackenzie 'Mack' Boyd,



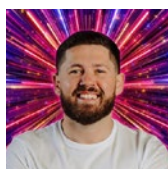
13. STRICTLY CONTESTANT: TABBY STOECKER

How to organise a successful Strictly sweepstake!

Organising and running a sweepstake is a fun and easy way to take part in some friendly rivalry and raise vital funds for seriously ill children. We all love the drama of Strictly and your sweepstake can add to your watching experience.

1

Decide who is in the sweepstake

It can be at your workplace, community group or with family and friends. Or you can run more than one if you are feeling adventurous for a variety of groups.

2

Decide on a prize

Maybe you can secure a donated prize from your employer or a local business. It could be a night out dancing, a share of the money raised or just bragging rights!

3

Spread the word!

Tell friends, family and colleagues and encourage them to enter and make a donation. Maybe you can create a dedicated Strictly Sweepstake WhatsApp group!

4

Draw the sweepstake

You can use our contestant sheet or any other method to allocate contestants. Get your players to draw at random and then assign each name to a player by filling in the sweepstake table.

5

Raise additional funds by holding a dance-inspired or musical event!

Feeling inspired by the dancers? You could raise additional funds for children with life-limiting conditions by hosting a dance or music based activity like karaoke or a music-based quiz!

6

Announce the winner!

Award the prize and let the winner bask in the glory of a great victory! Make sure to let everyone know how much was raised for children with life-limiting conditions.

Transfer your fundraising to Lifelites so we can put it to good use!

Rules and advice regarding sweepstakes:

- Keep the entry donation the same for everyone. If someone wants to donate a higher amount then collect this separately or direct them to Lifelites' website where they can securely donate.
- If fundraising at your workplace or community group, only those who work at the same site or are members of your group can enter and the draw must take place on the premises.
- You must not sell entry on the streets, house-to-house, online or through social media.
- Gift aid can't be applied to the money raised from a sweepstake.
